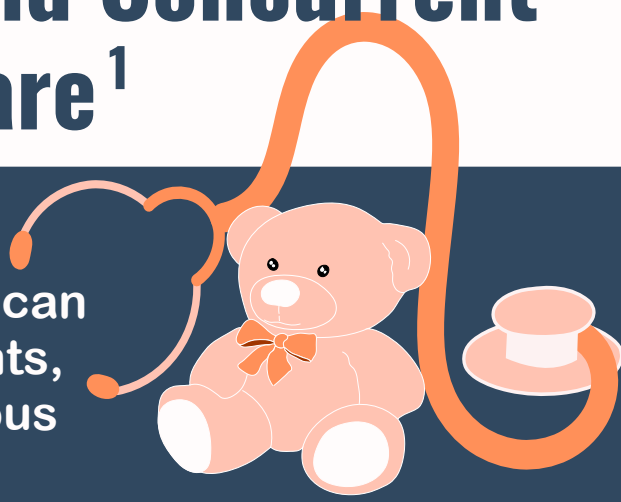


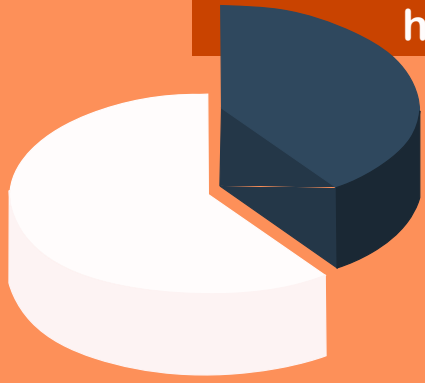

## Pediatric Concurrent Care

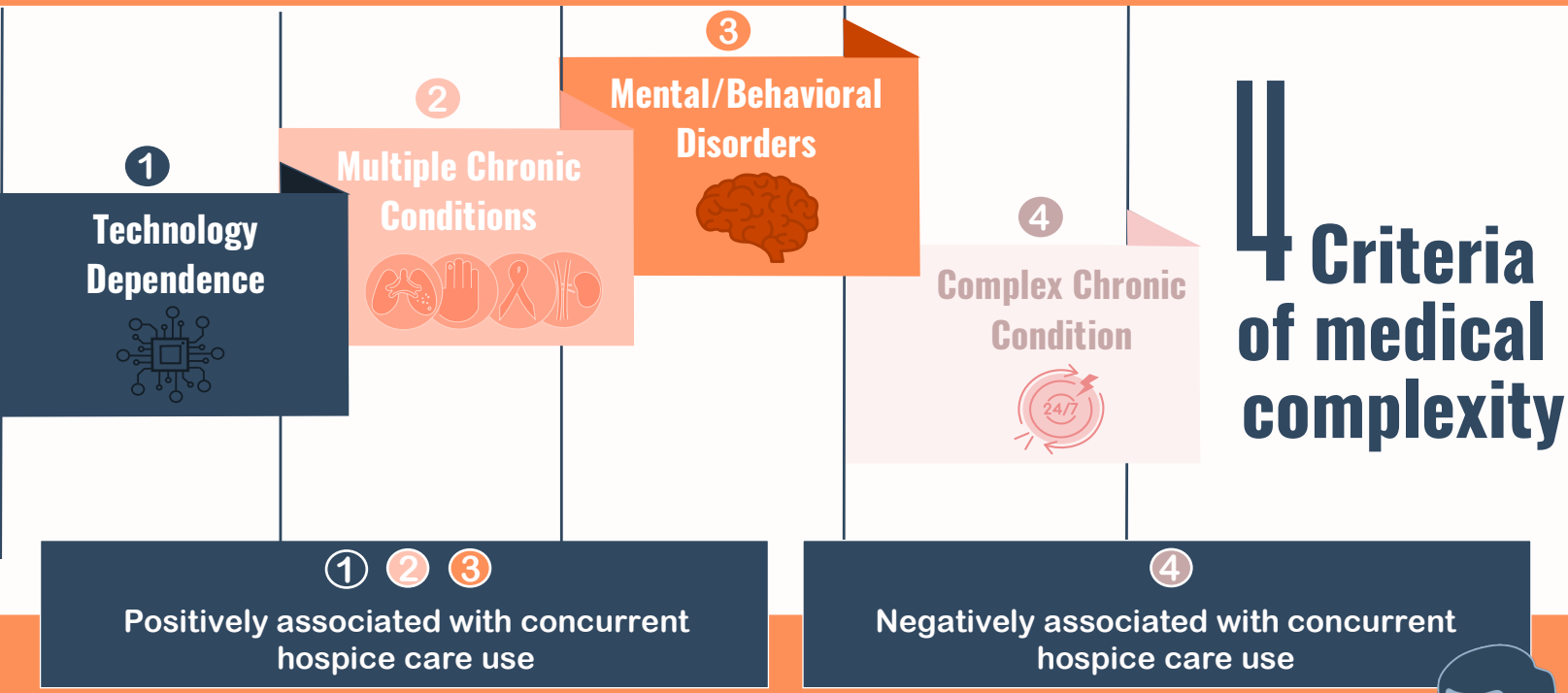
means Medicaid kids under the age of 21 can receive hospice care along with treatments, therapies, and medications for their serious illness

Individually, each criterion was related to concurrent care, but when combined together, they were not
