

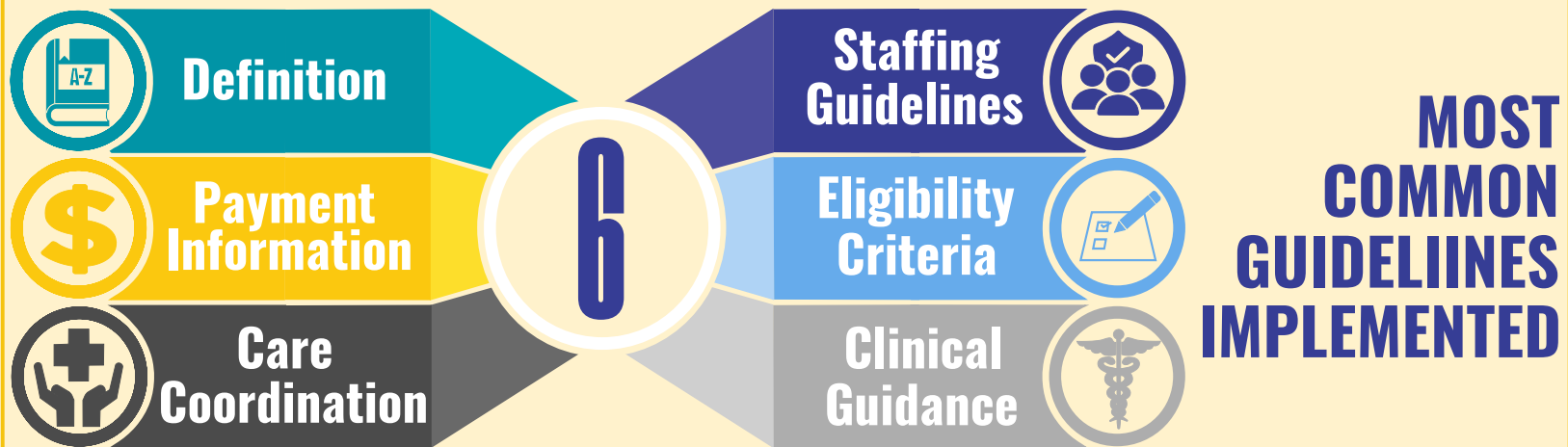
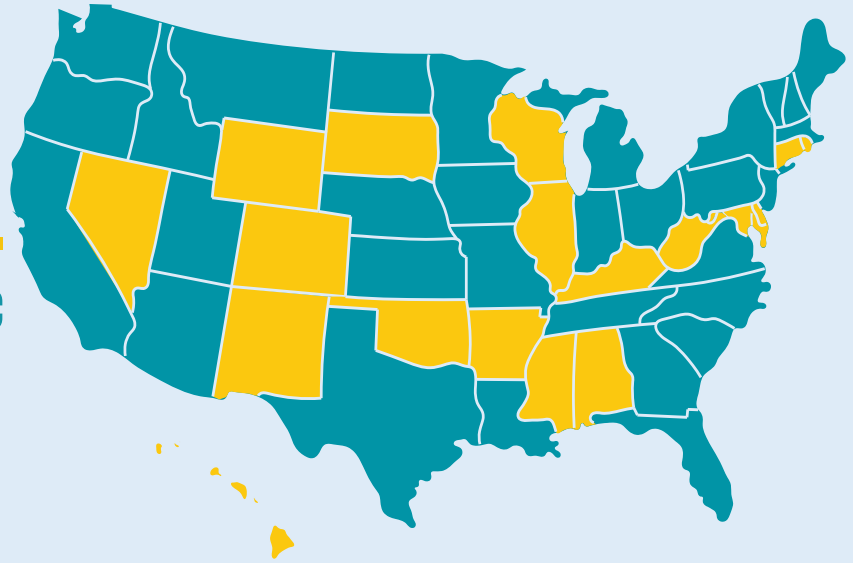
Variation in State Medicaid Implementation of the ACA: The Case of Concurrent Care for Children¹

19 STATES AND WASHINGTON, D.C. offered **NO** state-specific guidelines on concurrent care
